
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History of original corner establishment:

Corner established in 1883, by F.W. Campbell under General Land office Contract No. 486 Surveyor general records state: Set basalt stone 17x9x5 ins. 11ins. in ground for corner to sections 7,8,17,& 18 marked with 4 notches on S and 5 notches on E edges.

From which:
A pine 8" dia. bears S 67 E 231ks dist. marked T5S R30E S17 BT.
A pine 10" dia. bears N 51 E 60 1ks dist. marked T5S R30E S 8 BT.
A fir 8 ins. dia. bears S 57 W 651ks dist. marked T5S R30E S18BT.

A tamarack 6ins. dia. bears N 56 W 131ks dist. marked T5S R30E S7 BT.



Description of corner evidence found:

After a thourough search of the area no evidence is found. It appears that adjacent road construction & logging have destroyed all traces of the corner. Therefor set position by proportion.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set 3"x30" galv iron pipe with 3" brass cap 20" in the ground & raised a mound of stone around pipe. Stamped brass cap as shown in the diagram. From Which:

A fir 12" dia. bears N 51 42' E 63.5 ft. scribed T5S R30E S8 BT. A fir 12" dia. bears S 61 40' W 65.0 ft. Scibed T5S R30E S18 BT. A fir 12" dia. bears S 55 30' E 21.2 ft. " " " S17"

A steel post bears N 48 W 6.0 ft. with warning & bearing tree signs attached. Painted red band around each tree.

Bearing solar grid.

Note: No trees available in section 7.
