A 28" Pine, good condition, bears Slow, 50.2 ft., blaze healed.
A 30" Pine stump bears N9W, 151.4 ft., no scribes visable.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner

In place of stone, I set 22"x30" iron pipe with brass cap marked as shown, from which:

New BT

A 12" Pine bears N18W, 16.4 ft. marked T5S R30E S16 BT.

Nailed brass washer to BT blaze. Buried stone North and along side pipe. Set steel fence post 5+ North of corner. Used steel tape and magnetic compass with 20° E declination. Measured to face of blaze on original BTs and center of new BT.
