History of original comer establishment:

The original corner was established in 1882 by Rufus S. Moore as follows:

Set a Basalt Stone, 15"x13"x7", 10" into the ground marked " $\frac{1}{4}$ " on the west.

From which:

A 36" pine bears N43°E, 60 links (39.6 ft.). A 45" fir bears S85°W, 10 links (6.6 ft.).

Description of corner evidence found:

Original corner stone set firmly in the ground and marked "\dark" on the west face. Stone measures 18"x14"x7".

From which:

The original 36", now a 24" live ponderosa pine with scribes visible on a single partly healed blaze bears $N43^{\circ}E$, 40.7 ft. (39.6 ft. to the blazed face).

The original 45", now a 41" Douglas-fir snag 12 feet high with a single healed blaze bears $$88^{\circ}W$, 8.3 ft. to the center of the tree at the blaze (7.2 ft. to the blazed face).

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Moving the corner stone aside, I set in its place a 2"x30" galvanized iron pipe with a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " brass cap attached, 16" into the ground in a mound of stones. I bury the original corner stone alongside. The brass cap is marked:

TSS R34E

From which:

An 11" Douglas-fir, blazed & scribed "% S6 BT" on a single PLS 1636 blaze, bears N25°W, 21.6 feet.

Compass Declination: 180 East
