Description of corner evidence found:

At the corner found stone.

In section 4, found pine 28 dia. with blaze and in good shape.

In section 9, found down Tamarack log with scribe.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner

At the position of the corner I set a 30 galvanized pipe with an eight inch plate welded to bottom and a bronze cap on top. The hole was back filled with stone and tamped soil.

I stamped the disk.

From the monument the original bearing tree was; Pine 28th dia. N53°E, 32 lks dist. marked \$SBT. I established the following neww bearing tree; Red Fir 8th dia., S32°W at a distance of 2.9 ft. and scribed \$SBT;

The distance measured to center of respective trees on level.

I placed bearing tree signs on both old and new bearing trees and painted stripe around trees. I placed a steel fence post with USFS sign 54-4 attached near the corner.
