History of original corner establishment: Corner was originally established by Rufus S. Moore, U.S. Deputy Surveyor, under Contract No. 451, dated June 12, 1882. Surveyor General records state: Set a basalt stone 13 X 12 X 6 - 9 ins.in ground for corner to secs. 5, 6, 7, & 8, marked with 5 notches on the S and E edges, from which: A tamarack 15 ins in dia bears N 53° E 25 lks. dist marked. T5S R34E S5 BT. A tamarack 20 ins in dia bears N 45° W 78 lks.

A tamarack 24 ins. dia bears S 65° W 6 lks. dist. marked. T5S R34E S7 BT. A tamarack 32 ins. dia bears S 64° E 62 lks. dist. marked. T5S R34E S8 BT.

## Description of corner evidence found:

dist. marked. T5S R34E S6 BT.

A 16" western larch snag bears S 64° E- 62 links(40.9 feet), with open blaze and visible scribing. A 22" broken down western larch snag bears N 45° W- 78 links(51.5feet), with blaze lying on the ground in front of rotten stump.

Re-established corner by distance-distance intersection from the existing bearing tree remains.

## Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a  $2\frac{1}{2}$ "X30" aluminum pipe with  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap, 24"in ground and surrounded with a mound of stone to cap, marked as shown in corner diagram.

Attached sign 54-9 to steel fence post, set 4.0 feet North of monument.

New bearing trees established:

New bearing trees established: A  $9\frac{1}{2}$ " western larch bears N  $10\frac{1}{2}$ ° W - 57.3 feet, scribed: T5SR34ES6 BT. A 13" western larch bears N 11° E - 36.2 feet, scribed: T5SR34ES5 BT. A 20" white fir bears S 52° E - 50.0 feet, scribed: T5SR34ES8 BT.

A 14" white fir bears S 57° W - 37.5 feet, scribed: T5SR34ES7 BT.

New bearing trees have a brass washer stamped 'PLS 1106' nailed to face of blaze. Attached sign 54-3 & 54-9, painted face of blaze & a 6" red band around each bearing tree.

I hereby certify that the above corner was was properly re-monumented to U.S.F.S standards by me on October 22,1993.
