CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:


Corner originally established by Rufus S Moore, U.S. Deputy Surveyor, under GLO Contract No. 451, dated June 12, 1882.

Surveyor General records state:

Set a basalt stone $13 \times 8 \times 5$, 8 ins in the ground for 1/4 sec. cor. marked 1/4 on W face from which:

A pine 20 ins, in dia. bears S 48°E, 37 lks dist marked 1/4 S BT.

A pine 11 ins. in dia. bears S 70°W, 9 1ks dist marked 1/4 S BT.



Description of corner evidence found:

Found a basalt stone 13 x 8 x 5 ins marked 1/4 on West face firmly set in ground.

A ponderosa pine 28" in dia. with open blaze and visible scribe marks brs. $S48^{\circ}E,24.4'$ dist(37 lks) per record. No trace of Section 7 bearing tree.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At position of original corner stone...

Set a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap on $2\frac{1}{2}$ "x30" aluminum pipe 22" in ground surrounded with mound of stone only. Set steel fence post 4' North of corner & attached sign 54-9 & 54-2.

New bearing trees established: A $9\frac{1}{2}$ " ponderosa pine brs N47°W,79.7' scribed 1/487 BT. A 8" ponderosa pine brs N29°E,92.8' scribed 1/488 BT. A $11\frac{1}{2}$ "Western Larch brs.S51°W,96.4' scribed 1/487 BT.

New bearing trees have a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to face of blaze. Attached sign 54-3~&~54-9, painted face of blaze & a 6" red band around each bearing tree.

Compass declination 180 East.

I hereby certify that the above corner was properly re-monumented to U.S.F.S. standards by me on October 27, 1993.
