AT the position of the corner I set a 2" galvanized pipe 30" long with bronze cup on top and 8" plate welded to bottom. Pipe set to a depth of 20" and backfilled with stone and soil;

I stamped the disk

From the monument the original bearing tree is; A tamarack 18" in diam bears N32°W 20 1ks dist.

I set the following new bearing trees;

A tamarack 9" in diam bears N35°E 34.4 ft. marked T5S R34E S8BT; A tamarack 20" in diam bears S10E 24.2 ft. marked T5S R34E S17BT A black pine 11" in diam bears 381°W 39.5 ft. dist marked T5S R34E S18BT; (distances measured to center of respective trees and marked with scribe) I set a steel fence post with USFS sign 54-4 attached. I placed National

Forest boundary signs on the post indicating National Forest land to South and EAST. Bearing tree signs were placed on the bearing trees shoulder high facing the corner.
