
History of original corner establishment:

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

I set a $2\frac{1}{2}$ brass cap on a 30" galv. iron pipe, and stamped as shown above, in the ground, and placed a large mound of stone around the monument.

New bearing trees: A pine 5" dia. bears N 60 W, 15.25 feet, scribed 1/16S S17 BT. A pine 4" dia. bears N 36 E, 21.0 feet, scribed 1/16S S16 BT.
