Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner

AT the postion of the corner I set a 2" galvanized pire 30" long with a bronze cap on top and 8" plate welded to bottom. The pipe set to a de th of 12" and backfilled with stone and soil and raised a stone monument.

I stamped the disk

From the corner the original bearing tree is;
A black pine 14" in diam bears S21°W.
I set a new bearing tree as follows; A black pine 15" in diam
bears S64°E 75.9 ft. measured from center of tree and marked with a scribe 4SBT;
I set a steel fence post with USFS sign 54-4 attached. National Forest boundary
signs were placed on the post indicating NationalForest land to South andWEst.
USFS bearing tree signs were placed on bearing trees shoulder high facing
the corner.
