
## CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

## History of original corner establishment:

ESTABLISHED IN 1884 BY FRANK W. CAMPBELL:

Set a basalt stone 10 inches by 8 inches by 8 inches, 7 inches in the ground for closing corner for Sections 4 and 5 marked.



With 4 notches on the east and 2 notches on the west edges from which:

A 24" tamarack bears S. 37°E., 16 links (10.6 ft.) scribed T.6S., R.32E., S.4 BT

A 30" tamarack bears S. 80°W., 29 links (19.1 ft.) scribed T.6S., R.32E., S.5 BT

## Description of corner evidence found:

At the corner point, I find a charred, sharpened post 2 feet into the ground.

From which the remains of the original BTs:
A stump bears S. 45°E., 16 links (10.6 ft.) with scribes "BT" visible on an open blaze.

A stump bears S. 82°W., 29 links (19.1 ft.) with scribes "BT" visible on an open blaze.

## Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At the corner point: Set a 2½" x 30" iron pipe, 20" into the ground in a mound of stones, with a 3" brass cap marked:

T.5S.

R.32E.

From which:

A 10" fir bears S. 13°E., 112 links (73.9 ft.) scribed T.6S., R.32E., S.4 CC BT. A 16" fir bears S. 40°W., 137 links (90.4 ft.) scribed T.6S., R.32E., S.5 CC BT.
