
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Corner originally established by Frank W. Campbell under GLO contract number 468, dated April 12, 1883. Surveyor General record states:

Set a pine post 3 ft long 3 ins square 24 ins in ground for % sec cor marked %S on W face from which:

A Pine 10 ins dia brs S30°W 10 lks dist marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S BT A Pine 5 ins dia brs N65°E 20 lks dist marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S BT



No record of subsequent monumentation found in Umatilla County survey records. Description of corner evidence found:

Found no evidence of the original GLO corner or its accessories.

Found a $\frac{1}{2}$ inch diameter galvanized pipe 6 feet long driven 1 ft into the ground \$10°W, 10 feet from the corner position as determined by survey. I removed this pipe and placed it next to the new aluminum corner monument described below.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the

original location of this corner: At position determined by survey, I set a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown, 28 inches in the ground, from which;


New BTs: A 15 inch diameter Douglas Fir bears N56°E, 98.21 feet marked ½ S29 BT A 8 inch diameter Western Larch bears N2°W, 54.79 feet marked ½ S30 BT

I painted a 6 inch red band around all BTs and attached 54-3 and 54-9 signs.

Set a steel fencepost approximately 5 feet West with 54-9 and 54-2 signs attached.

I hereby certify that the above corner point was perpetuated as hereon described on July 14, 1987.

I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of new accessories. I used 17° East magnetic declination and the distances are to a 50d spike driven in the right side of the root crown. I attached a brass washer marked OPLS 644 to the BT blaze.
