History of original corner establishment:

The original corner was established by Frank W. Campbell on July 2, 1883, under GLO contract No. 468, as follows:

Set a post for the 1/4 corner, from which: A 18" tamarack bears S60 W, 10 links (6.6 feet). A 18" tamarack bears N80 E, 15 links (9.9 feet).

On July 16, 1987, Duane I. Griffith, PLS 644, found a 14" tamarack snag with a healed blaze, bears N80 E, 15 links. A 14" tamarack stump with a healed blaze which he opened to visible scribes, bears S60-W, 10 links. Griffith set a 2 1/2" aluminum pipe with aluminum cap attached, marked as shown in the diagram above, from which: A 12" spruce bears N53 E, 45.03 feet.
A 5" Lodgepole Pine bears N72 W, 26.36 feet.

Description of corner evidence found:

A 2 1/2" aluminum pipe with a 2 1/2" aluminum cap attached which is marked as shown in the diagram above. The cap is flush with the ground and is surrounded by a mound of stones, from which:
A burnt out root hole bears N88 E, 9.9 feet, all that remains of the

original Western Larch bearing tree.

A badly burnt Western Larch stump bears S65 , 6.6 feet. No marks remain.

A 11" Englemann Spruce snag with burnt out double blazes bears N56 30' E, 44.8 feet.

A burnt Lodgepole Pine stump, no marks remaining, bears N70 W, 26.4 feet.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

New accessories:

A 5/8" x 36" iron rod, set 35" into the ground with a 3/4" brass washer, marked "PLS 1636 S28 NE", attached at ground level, bears N47 30'E, 77.6 feet.

A 5/8" x 36" iron rod, set 35" into the ground with a 3/4" brass washer, marked "PLS 1636 S28 SE", attached at ground level, bears S68 30'E, 94.0 feet.

A 5/8" x 36" iron rod, set 35" into the ground with a 3/4" brass washer, marked "PLS 1636 S29 SW", attached at ground level, bears S48 30'W, 86.1 feet. This iron rod is about 30 feet southerly of a logging road which runs southeast and northwest.

A 5/8" x 36" iron rod, set 35" into the ground with a 3/4" brass washer, marked "PLS 1636 S29 NW", attached at ground level, bears N48 45'W, 91.9 feet.
