History of original corner establishment:

Corner originally established by Frank W. Campbell under GLO contract number 468, dated April 12, 1883. Surveyor General record states:

Set a granite stone 18x10x10 ins 12 inches in the ground for ¼ sec cor marked ¼ on W face from which:

A pine 24 ins dia brs S62°E 49 lks dist marked ¼S BT

A tamarack 12 ins dia brs N33°E 20 lks dist marked ¼S BT

Corner remonumented in 1977 by Craig L. Wanless, BLM

Group no. 350. His notes state; The ¼ cor of secs 32 and 33, monumented with the original unmarked granite stone 18x10x10 ins firmly set 4 ins in the ground, from which the remains of the original bearing trees; A pine 32 ins diam, bears S55°E 53 lks dist with healed blaze. (record S62°E 49 lks). A sawed Larch stump 17 ins diam bears N22°W 20 lks dist with scribes visible (record N33°E). At the corner point set an iron post with brass cap marked; (markings shown below) from which new bearing tree: A pine 18 ins diam bears N29°W 37 lks dist marked ¼ S32 BT.

Deposit corner stone alongside iron post.



No record of subsequent monumentation found in Umatilla County survey records. Description of corner evidence found:

Found a standard BLM brass cap marked as shown;

Original BTs: Found an 40 inch diam pine S55°E, 53 lks, live and vigorous with blaze evident. Found a 18 inch diameter Tamarack stump N22°W, 20 lks dist with scribes visible.

BLM BT: Found a 20 inch diameter Pine N29°W. 37 lks dist, live and vigorous with scribes visible.
