

Did not find the original post. Found the NW BT dead and down with obscure scribing visible. Found the NE BT as a broken oif stump about 5' high with the scribing very legible. No other evidence found.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the

original location of this corner Established the corner location using the BT evidence and info of above and set a 2"x30" galvanized pipe with a flared end and 22" bress cap 24" in the ground. Surrounded monument with a rock mound 6" high and 30" in diameter. Set a 4"x4"x6" redword post 20" in the ground 5' West of monument with signs 54-2 & 54-4 as guard post for corner. Scalped bark and painted red band around the new Bearing Trees and posted signs 54-3 with the following information:
