
History of original corner establishment:

Original Survey by Meldrum and Campbell Contract No. 380, 1881.

Set a Pine Post for 1/4 Sec. Cor.

Pine 40 in. dia. bears N43°E 118 1ks. Dist.

Fir 20" in dia. bears S55°W 29 lks. Dist.



Description of corner evidence found:

The remains of the original BT's.

A 26" Douglas Fir snag, previously opened, scribing "S"

A 26" Douglas Fir snag, previously opened, scribing "S" visible; and an approximate 20" Pine stump, rotten, no marks visible. No trace remains of the original Pine post corner monument. At the corner we find a 2 1/2" Iron Pipe, extending 6" above ground, with brass cap attached, marked: From Which the remains of the original BT's:

A 26" D. Fir snag bears S55°W 19.1 ft., and a 20" rotten Pine stump bears N43°E 77.9 ft., and new BT's apparently marked by BLM. A 10" Douglas Fir, with scribing "1/4 S 34 BT" visible on a single blaze bears N6°E 45.9 ft. And a 12 Douglas Fir with scribing 1/4 S3 BT" visible on a single blaze bears S80°E 30.7 ft. single blaze bears S80°E 30.7 ft.
