Began at cor Secs. 4-5-8-9 T. 3 N.; R. 28 E. N. M. which is a stone and iron pipe and 2x4 stake. Ran thence, West

Set temp. point.

could find no trace of  $\frac{1}{4}$  cor. searched thoroughly.

to fence cor. fences run N. S. E. W. could find no stone, but accepted this point as cor. Thence East on true line.

set stone  $\frac{1}{4}$  cor. marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  on S. face, brick under.

farther East set  $\frac{1}{16}$  cor. Stone marked  $\frac{1}{16}$  on top. 15x15x6" - 15" in ground.

Iron pipe under, and bottle at side.
